TUESDAY 26 SEPT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •MUFFIN BAKING - make fruit-filled muffins for a yummy afternoon tea. •CUP CAKE CASE ART - make butterflies and grasshoppers.
WEDS 27 SEPT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •EEL HUNTING ALONG THE WAIPAPA RIVER - a favourite trip to go fishing for eels, enjoy the springtime air, and play at Waipapa Landing. Before we leave, we will complete an eel fact-finding hunt on the school grounds to learn more about the eel's life cycle. •Turn a cardboard tube into a colourful sausage dog!
THURSDAY 28 SEPT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •PAPER PLATE FUN - make a wolf, flamingo, or hippo from paper plates.
FRIDAY 29 SEPT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •INLINE SKATING AT WAIPAPA - take the bus for a morning of skating at the Inline Skate rink. •TIN CAN CREATIONS - turn tin cans into owls and characters.
MONDAY 2 OCT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •PAINTED KERIKERI ROCKS - paint rocks ready to hide in our local area on Wednesday's trip. •FISHY TIMES -make a giant fish from cardboard and turn a CD into a fish!
TUESDAY 3 OCT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •PIZZA MAKING - make yummy pizzas and homemade garlic bread for afternoon tea. • TISSUE PAPER ART - make dragonflies and birds.
WEDS 4 OCT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • WALKING THE WAIROA STREAM WATERFALL PATH - beginning at school, we'll walk in stages to the Stone Store Reserve. After morning tea, we head along the stream to the waterfall for lunch. Our trip will end at Cobham Rd, where the bus will collect us, to return to school. We will hide KERIKERI ROCKS along the way. •TWISITNG FUN - turn pipe cleaners into trees.
THURSDAY 5 OCT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • FLOWERS GALORE - make a flower wall hanging. • Create a mixed-media flower collage.
FRIDAY 6 OCT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •MOVIE TIME - end the holidays by watching the latest kids' movie at the Cathay Cinema. Make a lion with dye and newspaper. •Pack up, ready for the last term of 2023.

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Trip Information

WEDNESDAY 27 SEPTEMBER - EEL FISHING ALONG THE WAIPAPA RIVER - We will depart school at **09.45am**, taking a gentle stroll down to Waipapa Landing for our morning tea. With full bellies, we'll split into smaller groups to hunt eels hiding in the shadows of the river (no hooks used). As we're all eco-warriors, we'll return any caught eels to their watery home! Everyone will meet up at Waipapa Landing for lunch and a play by the river, before walking back to school. We should be **back at school by 2.00pm**. **Children will need walking shoes and a warm layer of clothing. Please pack a large, healthy lunch and a water bottle.** This trip is subject to safe water levels and good weather conditions.



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FRIDAY 29 SEPTEMBER - IN-LINE SKATING AT THE WAIPAPA STADIUM - Leaving OSCAR at **09.45am**, we'll have a couple of hours at the Bay Sports Stadium in Waipapa, using in-line skates from the Kerikeri Inline Skating Club. There is a sprung floor and a beginners' area, so helmets are not usually needed. Children will be hungry by the time we get back for lunch. **Children will need LONG, THICK SOCKS** and something warm to wear afterwards. The bus will collect us at 12midday, returning to OSCAR for lunch.



WEDNESDAY 4 OCTOBER - WAIROA STREAM WALK - At **9.45am**, beginning at school, we will walk down the hill to the Stone Store Reserve. After morning tea, we will begin the Wairoa Stream walk, following the track alongside the stream, passing one waterfall, and stopping for lunch at the second larger waterfall. After lunch, we will complete the walk, ending on Cobham Rd (by the bridge opposite The Merchants). We will hide our **Kerikeri rocks** along the way. Here, the bus will collect everyone, for a well-deserved bus ride back to school. We will have plenty of rest stops along the way. **Children will need walking shoes, sun hat, and a warm layer of clothing. Please pack a large, healthy lunch and a water bottle.** This trip is subject to safe water levels and good weather conditions.

FRIDAY 6 OCTOBER - - MOVIE AT THE CATHAY CINEMA - We will check out the latest kids' movie at our local cinema. Timing for the day will be finalised when titles and times are available. Travel by bus. **Children will need shoes and a warm layer. Please do NOT send money for movie treats.**

- All external activities, which involve additional costs, are an extra \$10, making them \$60 days in total.
