Trip Information

WEDNESDAY 17 APRIL - EEL FISHING ALONG THE KERIKERI RIVER - Leaving school at 9.45am, we will stroll down to the to the Kororipo Reserve and have morning tea under the large tree. Then we will walk over the bridge to fish for eels in the river upstream of Kemp House. We'll have some bait and bamboo fishing rods for those that are keen to try their hand at

catching an eel – no hooks. There will be lots of helpers. After lunch, we will head back to school, aiming to be back by 2.00pm. Children will need shoes, sunhats, and clothing suitable for time in the sun, lunch, and a drink. This trip is dependent on good weather and safe river levels.

FRIDAY 19 APRIL -Te Araroa Track from Waipapa to

Rainbow Falls -Leaving school at 9.45am, the bus will take us along SH10 and drop us in Waipapa to meet the Te Araroa Track. We will walk along the river to our famous waterfall. Along the way, we will do a leaf and tree

scavenger hunt and kick some balls around the Waitōtara Drive reserve. The bus will collect us from the Rainbow Falls DOC carpark at 12midday to bring us back to school. Children will need shoes,

sunhats, and clothing suitable for time in the sun, lunch, and a drink. This trip is dependent on good weather and safe river levels.

WEDNESDAY 24 APRIL - IN-LINE SKATING AT THE WAIPAPA STADIUM

Leaving OSCAR at **9.45am**, we'll have a couple of hours at the BaySport Stadium in Waipapa, using in-line skates from the Kerikeri Inline Skating Club. Children are welcome to bring their own skates if they have them. There is a sprung floor and

a beginners' area, so helmets are not usually needed. Children will be hungry by the time we get back for lunch. Children will need LONG, THICK SOCKS and something warm to wear afterwards. The bus will collect us at 12midday, returning to OSCAR for lunch.

•First aid kits, your contact details, and cell phones will be taken on all trips.

•All external activities, which involve additional costs, are an extra \$10, making them '\$60 days' in total.

•Friendly reminder: A **\$50 bond** is required at the time of booking for **non-Riverview School students** to guarantee a place on our programme. This is either taken off your final invoice for the holiday programme or can be kept for future holiday programmes.
