Spring is here, so there's plenty of time to play all day, do arts 'n crafts, make new friends, bake yummy food, and enjoy local trips.



MONDAY 22 SEPT	• PAPER BAG CREATIONS - turn paper bags into owls & donkeys. • COCKADOODLEDOO - make a wacky rooster. • TRIOCEANS VISIT - activities on marine adaptations & the changing ocean environment.
TUESDAY 23 SEPT	• PIZZA MAKING - make yummy pizzas and homemade garlic bread for afternoon tea. • PAPER PLATE ANIMALS - turn paper plates into mice, a dinosaur & dogs.
WEDS 24 SEPT	• EEL HUNTING ALONG THE WAIPAPA RIVER - a favourite trip to go fishing for eels, enjoy the springtime air, and play at Waipapa Landing. Before we leave, we will complete an eel fact-finding hunt on the school grounds to learn more about the eel's life cycle. • SQUID CRAFT - use bits & bobs to make a squid mobile.
THURSDAY 25 SEPT	• CATS & DOGS - use cardboard tubes to make a cat & dog. Make a cat from a paper cone.
FRIDAY 26 SEPT	• MOVIES AT CATHAY CINEMA - we will take the bus to the cinema to watch the latest kids' movie. • WACKY CREATURE - use wooden pegs & other recycled bits to make a unique creature.
MONDAY 29 SEPT	• MOBILE ART - use popsicle sticks to make a mobile. Use pipe cleaners, beads & straws to make a mobile. • SUN CATCHER - make a monster shaped sun catcher.
TUESDAY 30 SEPT	• MUFFIN BAKING - make fruit-filled muffins for a yummy afternoon tea. • FLOWER COLLAGES - make a lovely lady collage. Create a colorful plant pot collage.
WEDS 1 OCT	• WALKING THE WAIROA STREAM WATERFALL PATH - we'll walk in stages to the Hidden waterfall. After morning tea, at the Stone Store Reserve we head along the stream to the waterfall for lunch. Our trip will end at Cobham Rd, where the bus will collect us, to return to school. • YAK AWAY - turn a cardboard tube into a yak & a paper plate into a goat.
THURSDAY 2 OCT	• ANIMAL ART - use dye to make a cool elephant. Use crayons & card to make a bird. Wrap wool around card to make a sheep. Turn a paper plate into a chicken. • COOKIE TIME - bake cookies for afternoon tea.
FRIDAY 3 OCT	• INLINE SKATING AT WAIPAPA - take the bus for a morning of skating at the Inline Skate rink. • STICK MAN - turn a stick into a cool stick man! • Pack up, ready for the last term of 2025.

Based in the Riverview school hall, all activities are supervised by Riverview School OSCAR's usual staff, with some extra helpers for trips.

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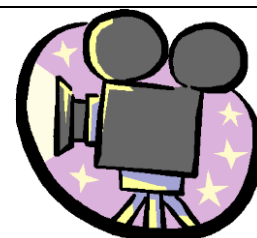
Trip Information

WEDNESDAY 24 SEPTEMBER – EEL FISHING ALONG THE WAIPAPA RIVER – We will depart school at **09.45am**, taking a gentle stroll down to Waipapa Landing for our morning tea. With full bellies, we'll hunt eels hiding in the shadows of the river (no hooks used). As we're all eco-warriors, we'll return any caught eels to their watery home! Everyone will meet up at Waipapa Landing for lunch and a play by the river, before walking back to school. We should be **back at school by 2.00pm**. **Children will need walking shoes and a warm layer of clothing. Please pack a large, healthy lunch and a water bottle.** This trip is subject to safe water levels and good weather conditions.



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FRIDAY 26 SEPTEMBER – CATHAY CINEMA MOVIE TRIP – We will take a bus to our local cinema to watch the latest kids' movie. Times to be confirmed nearer the date. **Please do NOT send money for snacks.**



WEDNESDAY 1 OCTOBER – WAIROA STREAM WALK – At **9.45am**, beginning at school, we will walk down the hill to the Stone Store Reserve. After morning tea, we will begin the Wairoa Stream walk, following the track alongside the stream, passing one waterfall, and stopping for lunch at the second larger waterfall. After lunch, we will complete the walk, ending on Cobham Rd (by the bridge opposite The Merchants). Here, the bus will collect everyone, for a well-deserved bus ride back to school. We will have plenty of rest stops along the way. **Children will need walking shoes, sun hat, and a warm layer of clothing. Please pack a large, healthy lunch and a water bottle.** This trip is subject to safe water levels and good weather conditions.

FRIDAY 3 OCTOBER – IN-LINE SKATING AT THE WAIPAPA STADIUM – Leaving OSCAR at **09.45am**, we'll have a couple of hours at the Bay Sports Stadium in Waipapa, using in-line skates from the Kerikeri Inline Skating Club. There is a sprung floor and a beginners' area, so helmets are not usually needed. Children will be hungry by the time we get back for lunch. **Children will need LONG, THICK SOCKS and something warm to wear afterwards.** The bus will collect us at 12midday, returning to OSCAR for lunch.

- All external activities, which involve additional costs, are an extra \$10, making them \$60 days in total.
- Friendly reminder: A \$50 bond is required at the time of booking for non-Riverview School students to guarantee a place on our programme. This is taken off your final invoice for the holiday programme or can be kept for future holiday programmes
