Road Safety / Pick-up Times

As you are all aware, the pick-up time can be very hectic. Please see the following reminders regarding safety and courtesy procedures:

- ◆ Please do not park over driveways or beside/ on the bus bay island
- ◆ Please do not park on the berms of the road, particularly if there are yellow dashed lines
- ◆ Please ensure that ALL children enter/leave cars from the left-hand side of the vehicle (i.e. the side closest to the berm/curb)
- ◆ We request that, if at all possible, whānau 'loop' around Kendall Road and line up to turn left into the roundabout
- ◆ Please ... NEVER park in the bus bay or roundabout
- ◆ Please, when you are driving along Riverview Road towards Landing Road, give way to any bus that is attempting to turn into the bus bay

We have recently met with representatives from the Council, as well as some concerned neighbours, over the dynamics around the 3:00pm pick-up and road safety. We will continue to work with them to ensure that we maintain a safe collection time for the children.

CAN YOU HELP MR KELLY?

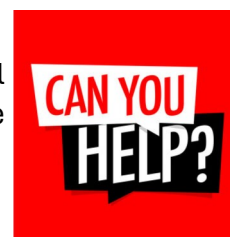
