PB4L HEARTWISE Expectations

Tuesday this week was 'Two-for Tuesday' for tokens.

Students that are still on Leg 1, Waka 1 or 2 were rewarded with up to three double tokens. That means that, instead of getting one token for an example of HEARTWISE behaviour, they could get TWO. This can only happen three times on a **'Two-for Tuesday'**.

For people that are on Leg 1, Waka 3 and higher, they were rewarded with one double token (i.e. two tokens for one example of HEARTWISE behaviour).


In other words, students got **two for one** (up to a maximum of three times for Leg 1 Waka 1 and 2, and once for Leg 1 Waka 3 and higher).
